## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Technical Suitability of Products program provides for the acceptance of new materials and products to be used in buildings financed with HUD-insured mortgages. This includes new singlefamily homes, multi-family housing and health care type facilities. Structural Engineering Bulletins (SEBs) are issued by HUD for structural systems, such as modular housing, log homes or panelized construction, and for subsystems such as roof or wall systems.

## **CRITERIA FOR CANCELLATION**

Structural Engineering Bulletins are subject to cancellation at any time. Causes for Cancellation may be based on several factors including, but not limited to:

- 1. Unacceptable performance of the component or housing unit, or sponsor's non-compliance with paragraph 2-7 of the Technical Suitability of Products Processing Procedures Handbook,
- 2. Failure of the sponsor to maintain proper quality control; failure to identify units or components fabricated under HUD requirements,
- 3. Nonproduction or cessation of operations, or change of address or corporate structure without notification to HUD,
- 4. Failure to report changes in the component or in production facilities,
- 5. Failure to correct poor performance, structural failures, or manufacturing defects,
- 6. Violation of prohibitions against advertising, or
- 7. Issuance of a more comprehensive form of acceptance, e.g., a SEB supersedes a State Letter of Acceptance (SLA). SLAs are issued when a HUD State Office accepts factory-produced housing in a specific geographical jurisdiction. SLAs have not been issued in approximately 30 years.
